WHEREAS, on March 10, 2015 in the case of In Re Adoption of N.J.A.C. 5:96 and 5:97 by NJ Council on Affordable Housing, the New Jersey Supreme Court issued its decision returning enforcement of the Fair Housing Act (“FHA”) and the Mount Laurel Doctrine to the New Jersey trial courts;

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Supreme Court provided that municipalities such as Voorhees Township (“Township”) may file a declaratory judgment action with the trial court and seek a judicial declaration that its housing plan presents a realistic opportunity for the provision of its fair share of present and prospective need for low and moderate income housing which may result in the Township’s receipt of the judicial equivalent of substantive certification and accompanying protection as afforded under the FHA;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court ruled that a municipalities’ Third Round fair share obligation and housing plan must be evaluated under the prior round methodology;

WHEREAS, in order to determine the Township’s Third Round affordable housing obligation it will be necessary to retain the services of a planning consultant for affordable housing matters who shall also be required to prepare any and all necessary documents including a Third Round Housing Element and Fair Share Plan to aid the Township in getting judicial approval of its Third Round affordable housing obligation, if any; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Committee deem it to be in the best interest of the Township and its residents to cause the issuance of a Request for Proposals for a planning consultant for affordable housing matters pursuant to the Fair and Open Process pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Township of Committee of the Township of Voorhees, County of Camden and State of New Jersey, that it hereby authorizes its qualified purchasing agent with the assistance of the Special Counsel for Affordable Housing Matters to prepare a Request for Proposals for a planning consultant for affordable housing matters in accordance with the above recitals; and


