Linda Heaton 1009 Mercer Ave. Voorhees, NJ

Mrs. Heaton addressed Township Committee with concerns regarding speeding traffic along Mercer Avenue, specifically where the street bends. She stated that there has been several times where she was almost struck by a car that was going too fast. She has since started to park her truck on the bend to force drivers to slow down. She feels this is helping. She continued by telling Committee that she was visited by a police officer who told her that she needed to mover her truck. She is asking for a speed hump to be installed on either side of the bend, or for stop signs to be placed at each side street intersection to alleviate the speeding problem.

Mayor Mignogna asked the Police Chief, who was in attendance, if there is anything that can be done to ease the speeding. Chief Bordi stated that stop signs are not legal in the manner in which Mrs. Heaton is describing. He did offer to have a speed monitor installed so that the speed of the traffic can be monitored. He will direct the traffic division to initiate the installation immediately.
