MR. DAVID THOMPSON

Mr. Thompson addressed committee and the public explaining that he is a 7<sup>th</sup> grade teacher at Voorhees Middle School and also the advisor of a new club called the Voorhees Middle School Trailblazers. He stated that 3 students would like to address committee with their ideas. This club's mission is to initially create walking trails from the Voorhees Middle School to Eastern High School through the Stafford Woods property. Mayor Mignogna welcomed Mr. Thompson and the 7<sup>th</sup> grade Trailblazers Club.

Ms. Sanchez stated that she is a member of the school's Township Committee Club and one of the 22 members of the new VMS Trailblazer's Club. They are here asking permission from Township Committee to maintain the trail between Voorhees Middle School and Eastern High School and to possibly expand it throughout the coming years. This would be open to the public. She added that her club members will create lasting memories through this project.

Ms. Harryman added that she is a member of the VMS Trailblazers Club and is asking for permission to build trails on township owned property. These trails would connect to the Eastern High School trail and Connelly Park. They would like to build the trails and be able see in the future that people are using and enjoying them. She stated that they are a team of enthusiastic kids who are very determined to build the trails for the community and to make a difference in their lives and the lives of the people who will use them. She added that she lives on a lake and since childhood she has hiked on that lake creating great memories for her. People would be able to see wildlife while hiking and the trails could bring people together. She voiced concern regarding the entrance to the trail on Evesham Road and stated that it is quite dangerous. The new trails would be safer to access. She hopes that township committee accepts their offer and allows them to make a change that would make the community better.

ABBY MOFFETT  
5 ADAM LANE

Ms. Moffett spoke in regards to the health and environmental benefits of adding trails to our community. She stated that trails and greenways create healthy recreation and transportation opportunities by providing people of all ages safe, accessible and no cost places for people to walk, jog, cycle and skate. These trails also add exercising to daily routines by connecting them to places that residents want or need to go. She added that as a community we want to make this activity fun and enjoyable for everyone. If we spread the word maybe society will join together and make our town a friendlier place. Ms. Moffett expressed the importance of bringing people together. She added that these trails could eliminate the need for so much driving, which would benefit the environment. She asked for permission from township committee to add to these trails.

Mayor Mignogna commended the students on the hard work they put forth in presenting their request for permission to add to the trails. They did a great job standing up and speaking before township committee and a tv camera.

Mr. Thompson stated that they have 2 major advantages in that they are very exuberant and they work for free. Mr. DiNatale asked if they had maps and estimated costs. Mr. Thompson said they plan to do the work themselves. He added that what they initially want to conquer is the deer trail that runs through the disc golf course. The goal would be to start a new entrance from VMS as opposed to walking up Evesham Road to access the trail. There is a rough trail that runs through the woods to VMS. He stated that the club would like to clean it up add signs and maybe a foot bridge. This would complete the trail from EHS to VMS. He added that the trail could also be utilized as an additional evacuation route in the event of an emergency. Mr. DiNatale said that funds could be available from our open space account that could be used to help with this project. He likes the idea of connecting the two schools and avoiding Evesham Road. He added that this is a great initiative and commended the kids for their enthusiasm. He offered township equipment and man power if needed and that they should contact Mr. Spellman. Mr. Thompson said their plan is to start small, but they do have plans for bigger projects. He added that he would like the students to do some fundraising if they need additional funds.

Mr. Platt added that the trails could also be used by the boys and girls track teams for training. There are other areas in town, such as the north branch conservation area that could connect to Cooper Road and further. This is publicly owned property that could be looked at in the future.

Mr. Thompson stated that the overall goal would be to come up with a walking trail or biking trail that would create a loop around Voorhees. This won't happen overnight. He said that the township has done a great job with providing open space in the township. Mr. Platt added that the club should reach out to our engineers for information regarding endangered or protected species that will need to be recognized and avoided.

Mayor Mignogna asked for a motion to allow the VMS Trailblazers Club to work on the trails in conjunction with township committee.

## RESOLUTION NO. 122-15

### GOVERNING BODY CERTIFICATION OF THE ANNUAL AUDIT

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A: 5-4 requires the governing body of every local unit to have made an annual audit of its books, accounts and financial transactions, and

**WHEREAS**, the Annual Report of Audit for the year 2013 has been filed by a Registered Municipal Accountant with the Municipal Clerk pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A: 5-6, and a copy has been received by each member of the governing body; and

**WHEREAS**, R.S. 52:27BB-34 authorizes the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey to prescribe reports pertaining to the local fiscal affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Finance Board has promulgated N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5, a regulation requiring that the governing body of each municipality shall, by resolution, certify to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that all members of the governing body have reviewed, as a minimum, the sections of the annual audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, the members of the governing body have personally reviewed, as a minimum, the Annual Report of Audit, and specifically the sections of the Annual Audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations, as evidenced by the group affidavit form of the governing body attached hereto; and

**WHEREAS**, such resolution of certification shall be adopted by the Governing Body no later than forty-five days after the receipt of the annual audit, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5; and

**WHEREAS**, all members of the governing body have received and have familiarized themselves with, at least, the minimum requirements of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey, as stated aforesaid and have subscribed to the affidavit, as provided by the Local Finance Board; and

**WHEREAS**, failure to comply with the regulations of the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey may subject the members of the local governing body to the penalty provisions of R.S. 52:27BB-52, to wit:

R.S. 52:27BB-52: A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.

**WHEREAS**, a resolution authorizing Voorhees Township to apply for the **2014 Recycling Tonnage Grant** will memorialize the commitment of Voorhees Township to recycling, and will indicate the assent of the Mayor and Township Committee to the efforts undertaken by Voorhees Township, and to the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, such a resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure the application is properly completed and timely filed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Voorhees, that Voorhees Township hereby endorses the submission of the Recycling Tonnage Grant Application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, and designates Dave Corsaro, Voorhees Township Public Works Supervisor, to ensure that the application is properly filed; and

**WHEREAS**, powers granted to Townships by N.J.S.A. 40A:63-1 et seq. give the Township Committee the ability to appoint multiple deputy mayors; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:63-4 grants a Township full power to exercise all powers of local government in such manner as its committee may determine; and

**WHEREAS**, a Township Committee may create such offices and positions as they deem necessary in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:63-6; and

**WHEREAS**, such officers appointed thereto shall perform the duties required by law and the ordinances of the committee; and

**WHEREAS**, on or about December 28, 2011, the Township Solicitor rendered a formal written legal opinion to the Business Administrator upon which he stated that under the broad powers granted to a Township Committee under N.J.S.A. 40A:63-4 and N.J.S.A. 40A:63-6, the Voorhees Township Committee, if it so desires, may appoint multiple deputy mayors; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 37:1-13 for the authorization to solemnize marriages and civil unions as follows:

“Each. . . any mayor or the deputy mayor when authorized by the mayor, or chairman of any township committee. . . of this State. . . are hereby authorized to solemnize marriages or civil unions between such persons as may lawfully enter into the matrimonial relation or civil union; and every religious society, institution or organization in this State may join together in marriage or civil union such persons according to the rules and customs of the society, institution or organization”; and

**WHEREAS**, Committeeman Michael Friedman has requested to be appointed to such position for a term of limited duration.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Voorhees as follows:

1. The provisions of the **WHEREAS** clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
2. Michael Friedman is hereby appointed as **DEPUTY MAYOR** of Voorhees Township from July 1, 2015 through July 31, 2015.

3. Voorhees Township Mayor Michael R. Mignogna hereby authorizes, following the appointment of Michael Friedman as Deputy Mayor, to perform marriages and civil unions during his terms as Deputy Mayor in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 37:1-13.
4. Nothing herein shall limit or affect the previous appointments to such position made at the Voorhees Township Reorganization Meeting conducted on Monday, January 5, 2015.


