AN ORDINANCE TO MANDATE DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES BY THE TOWNSHIP OF VOORHEES PURSUANT TO C.52:14-15f et. seq.

WHEREAS, P.L. 2013 c. 28, authorizes local governments to mandate direct deposit for certain governmental employees effective after July 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, P.L. 2013 c. 28 permits governing bodies to grant exemption on such terms and conditions as they deem necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township of Voorhees, located in the County of Camden, State of New Jersey according to the following:

- Section 1. All full time employees and elected public officials who receive compensation from the Township of Voorhees are mandated to have direct deposit of their compensation as of August 1, 2014 in accordance with Chapter 28 P.L. 2013, as defined under C.52:14-15f(b).
- Section 2. Seasonal and temporary employees who are employed by the Township of Voorhees are exempt from the direct deposit mandate.
- Section 3. If any Section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the Section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
- Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect January 1, 2017, after final passage, adoption and publication according to law.

WHEREAS, NJSA 40A:11-11(5) authorizes contracting units to establish a Cooperative Pricing System and to enter into Cooperative Pricing Agreements for its administration; and

WHEREAS, the Cranford Police Cooperative Pricing System (ID #47-CPCPS), hereinafter referred to as the "Lead Agency" has offered voluntary participation in a Cooperative Pricing System for the procurement of police utility vehicles; and

WHEREAS, on October 24, 2016, the governing body of Voorhees Township, County of Camden, State of New Jersey duly considered participation in a Cooperative Pricing System for the procurement of police utility vehicles;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. This RESOLUTION shall be known and may be cited as the Cooperative Pricing Resolution of the Township of Voorhees and Cranford Township.
- 2. Pursuant to the provisions of NJSA 40A:11-11(5), the Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperative Pricing Agreement with the Lead Agency.
- 3. The Lead Agency shall be responsible for complying with the provisions of the *LocalPublic Contracts Law (NJSA 40A:11-1 et seq.)* and all other provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey.
- 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

RESOLUTION NO. 219-16

AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN FINANCIAL INCENTIVE PILOT PROGRAM UNDER STATE HEALTH BENEFITS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Voorhees Township agrees to voluntarily participate in the Financial Incentive Pilot Program granting financial incentives to subscribers who select enrollment into tiered-network medical plans otherwise known as Horizon Blue Cross Blue Shield of New Jersey's OMNIA Plan or Aetna's Liberty plan. We agree that the management and administration of this incentive program shall be solely our responsibility; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the pilot incentive program described above shall include:

- The Pilot Program shall be available to subscribers who are first time enrollees in a tiered network medical plan beginning Plan Year 2017 and continuing for two plan years through December 31, 2018;
- The Pilot Program does not extend to participants enrolled under Chapter 375, P.L. 2005, (certain over-age adult children) and COBRA;
- Participation is voluntary at the option of the employer;
- The financial incentive for eligible employees shall be:
 - \$1,000 for Single member coverage when changing to a tiered-network plan.
 - \$1,250 for Member/Spouse coverage when changing to a tiered-network plan.
 - \$1,250 for Parent/Child coverage when changing to a tiered-network plan.
 - \$2,000 for Family coverage when changing to a tiered-network plan.

WHEREAS, the incentive amount shall be paid within the first quarter of Plan Year 2017 and is reportable income. The incentive shall be forfeited and returned to the employer if the subscriber fails to remain enrolled for at least two Plan years, except that if a subscriber is made ineligible for healthcare through layoff, involuntary separation, reduction to part-time status, or classification into an ineligible position. If a subscriber voluntarily retires or changes health plans due to a catastrophic or emergency health need as determined by the employer after a full year, then the incentive shall be forfeited on a pro-rata basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Voorhees, County of Camden, State of New Jersey that Voorhees Township will participate in the Financial Incentive Pilot Program under the State Health Benefits Program.

RESOLUTION ADMONISHING THE VOORHEES FIRE DISTRICT FOR FAILING TO RESPECT AND HONOR THE YOM KIPPUR HOLIDAY

WHEREAS, Yom Kippur is widely observed as a High Holy Day of the Jewish faith, marked by solemnity and deep moral and spiritual introspection; and

WHEREAS, Yom Kippur, also known as the Day of Atonement, is considered the holiest day on the Jewish calendar; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and each member of the Township Committee of the Township of Voorhees ("Township") respects and honors this High Holy Day by cancelling all public meetings on Yom Kippur; and

WHEREAS, the both the Voorhees and Eastern Regional Boards of Education honor this solemn High Holy Day by closing schools in observance thereof; and

WHEREAS, despite repeated requests to honor the High Holy Day of Yom Kippur, the Voorhees Fire District, traditionally holds its annual Fire Prevention Night on Yom Kippur there by ostracizing and alienating Voorhees residents and others who observe this holiday, preventing their attendance at this town-wide public safety event and obtaining valuable life-safety information for their families; and

WHEREAS, the Township is proud of its rich and diverse cultural make-up and heritage, and proudly recognizes all faiths including those members of our Jewish community; and

WHEREAS, the Township believes that religions traditions and holidays of all faiths should be respected and valued; and

WHEREAS, the Voorhees Fire District's failure and lack of sensitivity to respect the Yom Kippur holiday is an egregious transgression against all residents of the Township who observe this High Holy Day and well as those that do not; and

WHEREAS, given the prior notice, the Voorhees Fire District's scheduling of Fire Prevention Night on Yom Kippur, is ignorant, disrespectful, intolerant, and offensive; and

WHEREAS, the United Nations has recognized Yom Kippur as an official holiday and has ordered that no official meetings take place on this High Holy Day at the international body's New York Headquarters; and

WHEREAS, Yom Kippur is officially listed on the Voorhees Township Calendar, circulated to all residents and community service organizations each December, and

WHEREAS, nothing herein is intended to besmirch the hard working, brave Firefighters, EMS employees or other First Responders who place their lives on the line each and every day to protect the health, safety and welfare of our community.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Voorhees as follows:

- 1. The provisions of the WHEREAS clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
- 2. The Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Voorhees hereby admonishes and condemns the actions of the Voorhees Fire District for scheduling and conducting Fire Prevention Night on Yom Kippur as an act of total ignorance and intolerance to the religious beliefs of Voorhees residents and their families who observe this High Holy Day.
- 3. The Governing Body hereby calls for the Voorhees Fire District to publish a written apology to the community and commitment not to conduct community events on any religious holiday in the official Township newspaper within 30 days from the date hereof. In the event it fails to do so, the Governing Body calls

for the resignation of Fire District Chairman Thomas Hanney and Deputy Chief Mike Wharton for their lack of sensitivity by permitting the annual Voorhees Fire District, Fire Prevention Night to occur on the holiest day of the Jewish calendar.

RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE USE OF PARCC TESTING IN NEW JERSEY SCHOOLS

WHEREAS, our nation's future relies on a high-quality public education system that provides students with the opportunity to maximize their potential, instills lifelong learning, and promotes the development of engaged and informed global citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Voorhees believes that the current standards-based system is a top-down authoritarian system that disregards the professional decision-making ability of classroom teachers and usurps the local control of educating the children of the Township of Voorhees; and

WHEREAS, all children develop at different rates; and

WHEREAS, the efficacy of the Common Core State Standards (the Common Core) has never been evaluated relative to the previous New Jersey Core Content Curriculum Standards; and

WHEREAS, the Common Core has been integrally linked to the Partnership for Assessment of College and Career Readiness (PARCC) assessment in New Jersey by which students, teachers, administrators, schools and school districts will be evaluated; and

WHEREAS, the PARCC assessments are central to AchieveNJ, which uses student assessment data in the teacher evaluation process through student growth percentiles (SGP's) for public school teachers in certain grade levels and content areas; and

WHEREAS, the use of PARCC assessments or any Value-Added Model (VAM) for assessment purposes of children, schools, and teachers has not been shown to be a reliable method; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Education Association (N.J.E.A.), the New Jersey Association of School Administrators (N.J.A.S.A.), and the New Jersey School Board Association (N.J.S.B.A.) members have questioned the reliability of the data and the implementation of AchieveNJ and PARCC assessments; and

WHEREAS, the PARCC assessments will require that districts provide the means to test students in a computer-based testing environment; and

WHEREAS, AchieveNJ is an unfunded mandate and the PARCC assessments are a severely underfunded mandate; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey State Assembly previously introduced Assembly Bill A3081, which called for a delay in the use of the PARCC assessment data for any student or school accountability purposes, and calls for the creation of a task force to analyze the potential effects of the adoption of the Common Core State Standards, the new teacher evaluation system, and the use of PARCC assessments.

NOW, THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Voorhees, in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The provisions of the WHEREAS clauses set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.
- 2. A moratorium be placed on the use of the PARCC assessments and the accompanying administration evaluation mandates and an alternative thereto be evaluated and examined.
