

**ORDINANCE NO. 257-14**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 51 – SEWERS  
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF VOORHEES**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Voorhees, County of Camden, desires to amend Chapter 51 of the Township Code to impose certain restrictions on the discharge of storm water in the interest of the general health, safety and welfare of the Township of Voorhees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Voorhees, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 51.26(D) of the Code of the Township of Voorhees shall hereby be amended to delete items (2), (3) and (9)(a) and shall now read as follows:

**Section 1: § 51.27 IMPROPER DISPOSAL OF WASTE TO SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM.**

(D) Exceptions to prohibition.


- (1) Water line flushing and discharges from potable water sources.
- (2) Irrigation water (including landscape and lawn watering runoff).
- (3) Flows from springs, riparian habitats and wetlands, water reservoir discharges and diverted stream flows.
- (4) Residential car washing water and residential swimming pool discharges.
- (5) Sidewalk, driveway and street wash water.
- (6) Flows from firefighting activities.
- (7) Flows from rinsing of the following equipment with clean water.
  - (a) Equipment used in the application of salt and de-icing materials immediately following salt and de-icing applications. Prior to rinsing with clean water, all residual salt and de-icing materials must be removed from equipment and vehicles to the maximum extent practicable using dry cleaning methods (e.g. shoveling and sweeping). Recovered materials are to be returned to storage for reuse or properly discarded.
  - (b) Rinsing of equipment, as noted in the above situation is limited to exterior, undercarriage and exposed parts and does not apply to engines or other machinery.

**Section 2:** All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 3:** If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

**Section 4:** This Ordinance shall take effect on approval of the provisions and upon final passage and publication as required by law.
