

VOORHEES TOWNSHIP ENVIRONMENTAL MEETING NOTICE

Voorhees Township to conduct June 14, 2022, Environmental Commission Meeting via Video Teleconferencing

In accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act, recently adopted A-3850, and in consideration of Executive Order No. 103, issued by Governor Murphy on March 9, 2020, Voorhees Township will host its next Environmental Commission meeting via video teleconferencing on **June 14, 2022, at 7 p.m.** This action is being taken in order to limit any potential spread of COVID-19 and protect the safety of both residents, township staff, professionals, and applicants.

To facilitate the meeting, the township will be using the video conferencing service ZOOM to allow virtual participation by PC, Mac, smart phone, or tablet. The Voorhees Township Courtroom at the Voorhees Township Center, along all township facilities, remains closed to members of the public. However, for individuals unable to register for ZOOM digitally or dial into the meeting.

If members of the public wish to offer a public comment, Voorhees Township encourages members of the public to attend the Environmental Commission meeting virtually. Any member of the public who wishes to submit a public comment at this upcoming Environmental Commission meeting will be provided the ability to do so during a specific portion of the meeting.

Members of the public looking to offer a comment must follow the steps below.

Interested parties may submit written comments/questions, which those parties will read into the record the night of the hearing, by contacting the Environmental Commission Secretary via email at jgaffney@voorheesnj.com prior to the meeting, up until June 14, 2022 at 4:30pm. The comments/questions must include the individual's name and address, which the individual must also read into the record during the hearing.

Meeting Participation Rules:

1. All participants will be set to "listen only".
2. If a participant that has registered in ZOOM would like to comment during a portion of the meeting set aside for public participation, they must click the "Raise Hand" button and the host will unmute them.
3. If a participant who has dialed into ZOOM would like to comment during a portion set aside for public participation, they must dial *9 and the host will unmute them.

Further take notice, that said Voorhees Township Environmental Commission may, at its discretion, adjourn, postpone, or continue said hearings from time to time and you are hereby notified that you should make a diligent inquiry concerning such adjournments, postponements, or continuations.
