Mr. Norman summarized the application where the applicant is seeking a bulk "c" variance to permit proposed pool in rear yard, with relief from the following sections:

Section §152.015(D)(3), where accessory uses and structures are required to have a minimum side setback of 15' and the proposed pool is only 13.2' and the pool decking is only 10.2'; and Seeking any and all other variances, waivers and/or other relief as may be deemed necessary by the Board and/or its professionals.

Mr. William Boyle, Ms. Jackie Boyle, Ms. Toni Williamson of The Pool Store were all sworn in by Mr. Norman.

Mr. Boyle explained the request for the variance was due to an undue hardship due to wetlands buffer on the rear of the property. Ms. Williamson confirmed that the DEP would only permit Mr. & Mrs. Boyle to put the pool in that specific spot that required variances.

Mr. Cupersmith asked if Mr. Matlack, Board Engineer had anything to add. Mr. Matlack confirmed that he agreed with the location being the best location due to the wetlands buffer.
