Title: Mechanic
Department: Public Works

Responsibilities:

- Perform skilled mechanical work involving the maintenance, repair and servicing of gasoline and diesel motor vehicles, including special purpose vehicles and associated equipment such as trash trucks, dump trucks, pickup trucks, tractors, mowers, landscape equipment, snowplows and other vehicles/equipment.
- Communicate with drivers to diagnose mechanical defects by using available diagnostic equipment. Road test vehicles to determine operational defects and effectiveness of repairs. Order proper parts and/or communicate with proper facility to take corrective action to complete repair. Record and maintain service records for each vehicle and each piece of equipment. Maintain a clean shop. Ensure proper safety procedures are followed.
- Drive, operate, inspect, and maintain all types of public works trucks and equipment.
- Must be available for overtime duties including but not limited to emergency situations such as snow removal and leaf collection.

Requirements:

- A Commercial Driver's License valid in New Jersey is required. Any appointee that does not currently have a CDL will be required to obtain a Commercial Driver's License within six (6) months of appointment. The inability of an employee to obtain a CDL with six (6) months of hire shall constitute grounds for removal.

Training & Experience:

- Two (2) years of experience as a mechanic in the maintenance and repair of various types of motor vehicles and/or construction equipment. Successful completion of training in automotive technology school at an accredited college or vocational school is preferred.
- An Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) Certification in at least one (1) of the following specialties from the National Institute For Automotive Service Excellence is preferred: A-1 Engine Repair, A-6 Electrical/Electronic Systems, A-8 Engine Performance, L-1 Advanced Engine Performance Specialist.
- Applicants who do not possess the required formal training may substitute one (1) additional year of experience as outlined above.
